**SERMON TITLE: Whose Story?**

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**Questions:**

➤ **Comprehension:**

What does the passage say in your own words?

Do you have questions or things you don't understand?

➤ **Interpretation:** What is the purpose of the passage for them and for us?

➤ **Interpretation:** Why did the Lyconians want to offer sacrifices? Why would they have felt they needed to do this?

➤ **Application:** If someone curious about your faith asked you "Why do you choose to live the way you do?" how would you respond?

➤ **Application:** Try and imagine any scenario in your life today where you would be stoned almost to death for something and get back up again to talk about it. What has changed since then and what as Christians can we do about it? What does suffering for the sake of the Gospel look like today?

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**PREPARE:** Read [Acts 14:21-28](#) together in preparation for next week. Use this time together to explore where we are going and how we can better understand the text.

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➤ **What things stand out to you?**

➤ **Why was this important then?**

➤ **How can we apply it today?**

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➤ **Group Prayer:** Lord, we thank you for your goodness and for the opportunity to glorify you in our trials. Lord, we pray for those who don't know that they can know you. We pray for lives that reflect Jesus. Help us to submit to your will for our lives and for us to trust you and seek you daily. Amen.
