MAIN POINT: How can you know when God speaks to you?

SERMON SCRIPTURE: Acts 16:

REVIEW: <u>Acts 16:6-10</u> (Click the links in blue for easy reading!)

Questions:

> Comprehension:

What does the passage say in your own words? Questions or things you don't understand? Now is the time to ask!

Interpretation: What is the purpose of the passage for them and for us?

Interpretation: Do you think the disciples reflected Jesus along their travels while also not speaking the word? What might that have looked like?

▶ Application: Read together <u>Romans 8:5-6</u>. In what area of your life are you living in the flesh? Be honest with yourself and each other.

Application: We see Paul obedient despite inconvenience during his travels. What area of your life are you being called into obedience?

Dig Deeper: Additional Scripture from the Sermon to study throughout the week.

- 2. Acts 2:38

PREPARE: Read <u>Acts 16:11-15</u> together in preparation for next week. Use this time together to explore where we are going and how we can better understand the text.

- > What things stand out to you?
- > Why was this important then?
- > How can we apply it today?
