MAIN POINT: The Gospel demands a response. How will you respond to the Gospel?

SERMON SCRIPTURE: Acts 16:24

REVIEW: Acts 16:24 (Click the links in blue for easy reading!)

Use this time to revisit the Scripture and Sermon together. Encourage open and honest conversation while asking and answering questions as a group.

Questions:

> Comprehension:

What does the passage say in your own words? Questions or things you don't understand? Now is the time to ask!

- **▶ Interpretation:** What is the purpose of the passage for them and for us?
- ➤ Interpretation: Why do you think the girl following Silas and Paul was a problem?
- **▶ Application:** Does this text change the way you think about sharing the Gospel? Why or why not?
- **▶ Application:** How does this passage challenge the way you are currently living out the Gospel?
- **▶ Dig Deeper:** Additional Scripture from the Sermon to study throughout the week.
 - 1. **Ephesians 6:10-12**
 - 2. Micah 6:8
 - 3. 1 Peter 4:12-14, 16
 - 4. Deuteronomy 30:19a

PREPARE: Read <u>Acts 16:25-40</u> together in preparation for next week. Use this time together to explore where we are going and how we can better understand the text.

- > Why was this important then?
- > How can we apply it today?
- ➤ **Group Prayer:** Break into groups of 2-3 and spend a few moments discussing how you can pray for each other. Each member of the small group takes turns praying.
