**SERMON TITLE:** Keep On Going

**MAIN POINT:** We have been called to tell the world about Jesus and know that we are not alone.

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## Questions:

➤ **Comprehension:**

What does the passage say in your own words?

Questions or things you don't understand? Now is the time to ask!

➤ **Interpretation:** What is the purpose of the passage for them and for us?

➤ **Interpretation** Paul lived with the people in Corinth for a year and a half. Discuss together what his life might have looked like. Think about his daily routines and the people he lived and worked alongside. How does this help you understand Paul?

➤ **Interpretation** What can you learn from how Paul was sharing the Gospel in Corinth?

➤ **Interpretation** What was Gallios responsibility and jurisdiction as a Roman Proconsul? Why do you think he did not get involved?

➤ **Application:** Read together [Acts 18:9-10](#) again as a group. How do these words from God to Paul challenge you as a Christian today?

➤ **Application:** Read together [Ephesians 6:19-20](#). What does it mean in your life to be an ambassador and to speak boldly the message of the Gospel? Who in your life needs you to do this?

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➤ **Dig Deeper:** Additional Scripture from the Sermon to study throughout the week.
