

Organ Renovation Updates

Pipes Removed, Organ Chamber Work Begins

The organ renovation project officially began on Wednesday, July 9 when Reinhardt Construction arrived at the church to construct scaffolding in the sanctuary that would help them remove the large wooden grates from the



walls. This scaffolding stayed in place to assist Levsen Organ Company and volunteers from FCC in removing pipes from the organ chambers early on Tuesday, July 15.

Thanks in part to our AWESOME volunteers, the first phase of the project is nearly complete. All but the very biggest few pipes have been removed from our organ chamber, and have been safely relocated for cleaning. Our deepest gratitude goes to everyone who helped with this effort. Your time, energy, and good spirits have truly made a difference. The final "chests" will be removed by volunteers this week, allowing Reinhardt Construction to begin repairing damages to the organ chamber.

We're also pleased to share that the team from Levsen Organ Co. commented on how remarkably helpful and enthusiastic our volunteers have been. Rodney Jr. and his grandson both told me separately that our team stands out as one that was particularly eager and engaged. In the coming days, Reinhardt Construction will begin addressing water damage and other issues in the organ chamber to... (cont'd on page 3)
