
### Loaves & Fishes

### Sunday Morning Security

New Door Protocol for Sunday mornings

On Sunday, October 12, we test ran a new security protocol for the church during worship on Sunday mornings. We hope to continue to test this system over the next few weeks, so we're looking for feedback



from you all as we do so! Beginning at 10:45 a.m. on Sunday mornings, the kitchen, portico, and office entryway doors will be locked in order to keep the building more secure during worship. The Narthex and Sanctuary doors (bell tower door and north door) will remain OPEN during worship. This means that all doors to the building will remain open leading up to the late service (7:00 a.m. - 10:45 a.m.), but once worship begins at 10:30 a.m., members and visitors will have 15 minutes to enter any external door other than the sanctuary doors. While only two doors will be accessible from the outside of the building, all five exterior doors mentioned will be accessible as exits, in case of a fire or other emergency.

Overall, this means that if you are someone who arrives after 10:45 a.m. for worship, you will either need to navigate around the building to the two sanctuary/narthex doors on 10<sup>th</sup> street, *or* ring the door bell and Maria, our weekend custodian, will let you by opening the doors from the office.
