





Levsen plans to return to Columbia in early November with our newly restored wind chests to reinstall them and begin the process of cleaning and reinstalling the organ pipes. This process may take several weeks, so we will be looking for a few volunteers with flexible schedules who may be able to assist Levsen with this project.
