



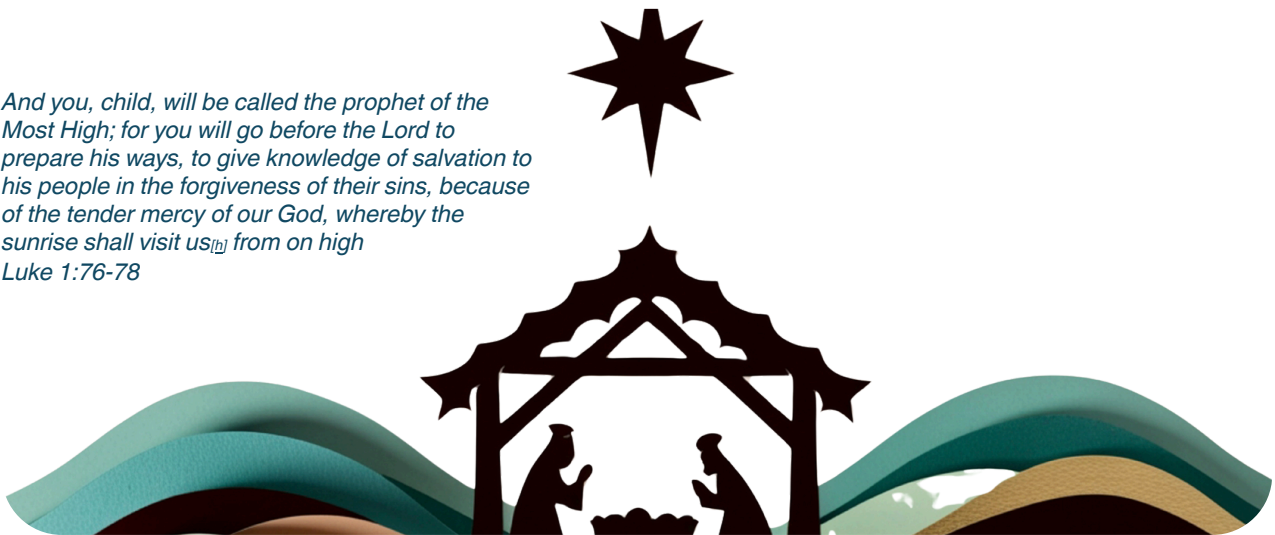

We encourage you to start with us on Jan 1st, but really just start whenever you can. Here are a couple options to follow our plan, but most importantly we encourage you to do it however you can!

We are providing you two ways to follow our plan for reading:

1. **The LCC App:** You can access the reading plan right on your LCC App! Simply open the app and select the Bible icon at the bottom. Then you should see a calendar icon with Plan text. Touch this icon and it will open to the first day (scheduled to start Jan 1, but you can start anytime) Once you complete the first reading the next one will show up each day.
