INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS

YEAR 1

1. Serve regularly on a ministry team

Satisfies competencies 1, 19, 21, 24, and 31 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Students are required to serve a minimum of twice per month AND attend required ministry meetings. Go to nr.church/service to discover opportunities to serve and be sure to fill out the “**serving interest form**” at the bottom to begin the process of joining a team.

2. Discuss volunteer development with your ministry team leader

Satisfies competencies 20, 22, and 23 of the Beginning Ministerial Internship

Your ministry team leader will be determined by the team you serve on **OR** by the North Ridge School of Ministry instructors.

3. Lead Classroom Prayer Liturgy
