Ezra & Nehemiah (Ezra 1-3; Nehemiah 1)

Brite Idea: God works through His people.

Memory Verse:

But if you return to me and obey my commands and live by them then even if you are exiled to the ends of the earth, I will bring you back to the place I have chosen for my name to be honored. ~ Nehemiah 1:9
