The past couple of months have been full here in Hong Kong with both family and ministry life. Just before Easter, our church hosted a children's camp for elementary students. We were thankful to have over 20 campers attend, along with several parents who participated as sponsors. About half of the children were invited by church families and do not regularly attend, making it a great opportunity to connect with new families.

Our incredible team of volunteers did a fantastic job coordinating and leading the camp, which allowed our family to take a short trip back to the U.S. for Ashli's sister's wedding. Although we hadn't planned on returning to the States so soon after arriving in Hong Kong, after prayer and counsel from our sending pastors—and with confidence in our team to lead the camp and other Easter events—we took a short but eventful 10-day trip to Southern California.

While there, we enjoyed sweet time with family and fellowship with one of our sending churches – Liberty Baptist. We also got to connect with a young man (Joshua) from our Hong Kong church who is currently attending college in the Los Angeles area. Since arriving in the U.S. this spring, he has been faithfully bringing classmates to church every Sunday. Several have also trusted Christ! It was incredibly encouraging to see his spiritual growth in just a few short months and how God has been using him.

Upon returning to Hong Kong, the rest of April and May were filled with ministry events. We celebrated Mother's Day with a special tea after service and welcomed a number of first-time guests, including several unsaved mothers. We also enjoyed a fun "squid fishing" trip with our church family and shared great fellowship over our catches! At the end of May, we had the joy of baptizing Mrs. Law, who began attending several months ago. She shared a short testimony in preparation for her baptism, and it was a powerful reminder of how God is at work. I've included a link to a translated version below—I trust it will encourage you. Thanks again to the Lord's provision, we were able to pay in full with funds He had already supplied. We honestly can't explain it—only praise Him for His abundant grace. We're eager to see how these new tools will allow us to continue reaching and serving the people He's placed in our lives.

We recently had them over for a meal and are praying God will work in their hearts and draw them to Himself.
