Recently we have had some younger people attending Sunday morning services at church. Young, British men who live locally and want a Bible preaching church to worship in. Sound Biblical teaching is rare in churches in the U.K today, and it's a blessing to see a hunger for truth in the next generation. I am praying they'll continue to come and build a foundation for their faith.

Our regular ministries are going well. With fine weather these last few weeks, we've been back out delivering New Testaments to houses in the community—and I'm always mindful that this outreach has been our most effective in bringing new people to church. Our missionary ladies, Marcia and Reta with Linda continue to make Cake Day a highlight—we're thankful for their faithfulness and the warm, welcoming atmosphere they create, often drawing in those who might not attend a service but are happy to sit down for a tea and a chat. It's in those moments that hearts are softened and doors open for the Gospel.

Please pray for Virginia (whom I mentioned in my previous prayer letter). Her son in Australia fell out of a cherry-picker and suffered brain damage. He has since come out of ICU and has been making incremental steps in recovery. Virgina has relocated to be with her son she remains committed to Jesus, and I know she'd appreciate your prayers for her son and the family.

Nattacha has been taking medication to manage some recent health challenges, so please continue to keep her in your prayers. After the summer, both Nattacha and Mai will be entering their final year of university, with some significant decisions ahead as they prepare for the next chapter of their lives. Where does the time go?

Some great news! Linda became a British citizen! She made it! Thank the Lord... and, yes, fish n'chips is now compulsory.

And, some news regarding the novel, The Final Witness. I wrote this story to encourage young Christians in their faith.
