Parent Corner – Ephesians 2:11–22

This week's passage reminds us that **Jesus is our peace**. He broke down the dividing wall between us and God — and between each other.

Paul tells the Ephesians (and us) that in Christ, we are:

- Brought near by His blood
- No longer strangers but members of God's household
- Built together into a dwelling place for God's Spirit

Take time to read Ephesians 2:11–22 together as a family and discuss:

- 1. What does it mean to be "brought near" to God?
- 2. How has Jesus given us peace and unity with others?
- 3. How can our family reflect God's love to people who feel "far off"?

This is a great opportunity to celebrate what God is doing in your student's life — helping them walk closer with Him day by day.
