What puts you in the mood for Christmas? Is it colder weather in the month of December? Could it be putting up the Christmas tree and decorating it? Even still, is it the sending and receiving of Christmas cards in the mail?

For me, several things help get me in the "Christmas spirit", but I'd have to say that Christmas music rises to the top of my list!

I did a quick "Google" search of the top Christmas songs, and I know some of you may cringe to hear that one site reported that Mariah Carey's song, "All I Want for Christmas Is You", came in as the number one favorite Christmas song.
