**Q. Who exactly is the Holy Spirit?**

**READ** John 14:16–17

**A**

The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Trinity. He is fully God, He is co-equal with the Father and the Son. He is personal, not just a force, and works to reveal Jesus, guide Christians, and empower God's people.

**Q. When do I receive the Holy Spirit?**

**READ** Acts 2:38

**A**

According to Scripture, a person receives the Holy Spirit the moment they trust in Jesus Christ as Savior. The Spirit comes to dwell in Christians permanently, marking them as God's own and empowering them to live for Him. It is not based on works or rituals but on faith in Christ.

**Q. What is the Holy Spirit up to?**

**READ** John 16:13–14

**A**

The Spirit convicts people of sin, reveals God's truth, glorifies Jesus, equips Christians with gifts, and produces spiritual fruit in their lives. His work is always to advance God's kingdom and the mission of Jesus.

**Q. Does the Holy Spirit do anything in my life?**

**READ** Galatians 5:22–23

**A**

Yes. The Spirit dwells in every Christian, helping us understand Scripture, pray, grow in Christlikeness, and obey God. He empowers ordinary people to live holy lives and serve others.

**Q. Can I see or touch the Holy Spirit?**

**READ** John 3:8

**A**

No. The Spirit is invisible, but His presence is real. We see His work in changed lives, obedience, spiritual growth, and the fruit He produces in Christians.

## Q. Is the Holy Spirit God?

**READ** Acts 5:3-4

**A** Yes. The Spirit is fully divine, eternal, and shares the same power, glory, and authority as the Father and the Son. He is worshiped and obeyed as God in Scripture.



## Q. Can someone resist the Holy Spirit or grieve Him?

**READ** Ephesians 4:30

**A** Yes. People can resist God's guidance and grieve the Spirit through disobedience, sin, or rejecting His work in their lives. Christians are called to walk in step with the Spirit.

## Q. How can the Holy Spirit help me?

**READ** Romans 8:26

**A** The Spirit helps us understand Scripture, guides our decisions, strengthens our faith, empowers us to serve, comforts us in trials, and produces Christlike character in our lives.
