ROYAL RANGER RULES OF CONDUCT

BEFORE THE MEETING

- > Running in the Church is not permitted.
- ➤ Fighting and rough housing is not permitted.
- > There are to be no toys brought in (bats, balls, etc.) unless asked for by the leader.
- ➤ Once arriving for Royal Rangers, you are to stay in the meeting room until you are assigned by a leader to another location.
- Proper respect is to be given to all Leaders at all times.

DURING THE MEETING

- ➤ Boys are to be attentive and allowed to speak only after raising there hands and being recognized by the Leader in charge or the person speaking.
- > During recreation, while passing in the Church halls, there will be no talking allowed, in order not to disrupt any other classes in progress.
- ➤ Boys will give the person in charge their full attention.
- ➤ Defacing of any type of property will result in the removal from the Royal Ranger program.

AFTER THE MEETING

- ➤ The boys will be responsible for their own things and are to pick-up all books and papers that belong to them and bring them home.
- > The boys will be dismissed to the care of their parents at the end of the meeting.

- C. To keep boys in our churches

Our Aim

To instruct, challenge, and inspire our boys in the areas of Bible doctrine, Christian service, moral conduct, and basic beliefs of our church through interesting activities the boys enjoy.

Our Goals

- 1. *To instruct in Bible doctrine*. When a boy completes this program he should have a basic knowledge of what the Bible teaches.
- 2. *To challenge for Christian service*. When a boy completes this program he should be ready to take his place in the area of Christian service where God wishes him to be.
- 3. *To inspire a belief in the fundamental beliefs of our church.* When a boy completes this program he should be Christian in belief the remainder of his life.
- 4. *To satisfy the boy's basic need for activity.* A boy engaged in this program should have enough interesting activities to do to prevent him from being tempted to engage in unwholesome activities.
