Dear Pastor and Church Family,

Happy New Year from Thailand! Each year during the Christmas season, we see more and more decorations and hear Christmas music throughout Thailand. While most Thai people do not understand the true meaning of Christmas, it provides a wonderful opportunity to share the Gospel. We had a great time passing out cookies and tracts with our young sons, and most importantly, sharing the story of the greatest gift of all, Jesus Christ.

Thank you to everyone who prayed for the events mentioned in our last letter—the trip to a bordering communist country and our special Teen Rally. God truly blessed both. During our journey out of Thailand, we experienced a few unexpected issues with immigration, but that is part of mission life. Once we arrived in the bordering country, we were able to meet with the Bible institute there and interview seven pastors for support through CORE Missions. It was a blessing to hear their testimonies and learn about the challenges they face in ministry. Our desire is to provide temporary support so these pastors can focus on building strong local churches that will eventually become self-supporting. Six of the pastors were from that communist country, and one pastor was from Thailand. After meeting with them and our local ministry partners, we are excited to welcome these seven pastors into the CORE program! After returning to our city in Thailand, we hosted our first Teen Day and welcomed around 75 teenagers. The goal of this event was to preach the Gospel, encourage the teenagers through God's Word, and provide fellowship with other believers. The day was filled with preaching, food, games, and fellowship. These young people face many obstacles, yet they have tremendous potential to serve the Lord if they choose to follow Him. We are praying for the future of Thailand, and we believe it begins with the next generation. We are thankful for the decisions that were made for Christ. We appreciate your continued prayers for our next Teen Day at the end of January.

This December 29 we celebrated six years of living in Thailand! It is amazing to look back and see how far the Lord has brought us and to reflect on how our family has grown. We are grateful for the opportunity to serve here and look forward to many more years of ministry in Thailand.

As we look ahead to the new year and seek ways to grow personally and in our ministry, we want to thank you for your faithful prayers and support for our family. Our desire is expressed in 1 Corinthians 4:2: "Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful."
