With the financial gifts given at the BEST Conference in September, we were able to help several Pastors get Bibles this past month. We were able to help a Pastor in a creative access country receive Bibles for his Pastors Conference. We were able to help Pastor Adelwaye Adesina with the remaining funds he needed to print 2,000 Yoruba Bibles in Nigeria. Tan was able to get whole Bibles for some tribal churches in another creative access country in Southeast Asia. He will be traveling to that country in November to help distribute them. Tan has also ordered more Gospel tracts in Thai for the churches in Thailand. We are waiting on the estimate from our printer in northern Thailand for more Thai Soul Winners New Testaments. We were able to send World Missions Bearing Precious Seed about half of the funds needed for the Guam Scripture project. None of this would be possible without the sacrificial giving of God's people and supporting churches. Thank you so much for helping us get the Gospel and the Word of God to the regions beyond!


We were blessed to have meetings in Maine, Nebraska, Kentucky, Illinois, and Georgia this past month. Three of these meetings were missions' conferences. We keep thinking it will slow down one day but it seems to be picking up momentum and not slowing down at all. In all these locations we have been blessed to share the Gospel with folks and help plant seeds or water seeds along the way.


In October Tan was able to go to Singapore and meet with Pastors there about the possibility of expanding our distribution to that part of Southeast Asia. Please pray with us about this opportunity.


During our travels, Amber broke off part of a tooth. Upon getting in to see our dentist, it was discovered that she needed some extensive dental work done. Please pray for her healing and for the finances to cover this unexpected cost as we do not have dental insurance.

September seemed to just fly by! We started the month with our eighth annual BEST Missions Bible Conference at our sending church, Colonial Baptist Church in Rogers, AR. We had a great lineup of speakers for the conference who all preached phenomenal messages. This was the first year Tan was able to be at the conference. He preached on Tuesday morning and did a great job! His being there and testifying as to the importance and the blessing the Bibles are for people in Southeast Asia was an added bonus for the attendees. We were able to get Tan back to Thailand in time to surprise his wife, Pim, for her birthday.

After the conference, we got ready for a long stretch of being on the road away from Arkansas. We started our trip with a meeting in Texas before heading to the Northeast. We enjoyed a meeting in Pennsylvania then headed up to New England to be a part of a Family Camp in Liberty, ME. There were 168 registered campers and seven churches represented. I believe many families were helped by their own testimonies. We enjoyed being able to present BEST Missions not only to the churches at the camp but also to two more new churches. We are very thankful that the church in Pennsylvania voted to take us for support. We found out right after they voted that our insurance provider was increasing our monthly amount starting in 2026. What they took us on for will cover the increase. What a great, loving Heavenly Father we have!!!

At the time of writing this letter we are still in Maine and have more churches to present BEST Missions to before traveling on. Please pray for our traveling mercies.

I am also happy to report that \$50,807.29 was given at the BEST Conference for our various Scripture projects including the Guam John and Romans project. This amount will allow us to cover some of our smaller projects in Southeast Asia as well. What a blessing it is to have a copy of God's Word! Throughout the month of September BEST Missions was able to distribute 2,692 whole Bibles, 320 New Testaments, and 62,906 John and Romans.
