DIY projects:

Paying down the mortgage, conducting ministry in a very high cost region and saving for the roof repair kept the ministry lean and the building somewhat run down. We have tried hard over the years to pay for ministry expenses out of Irish giving. With the a re-slated roof now finished (on budget, thankfully!) we were free to finally address some long standing maintenance issues. The cost of labour is exceptionally high. Skilled craftsmen are hard to come by and prices vary widely. I end up doing a good bit of the work along with a few men who help out. We have made good progress hiring and working alongside craftsmen as we resurfaced the floor, installed new lights in the auditorium, re-plastered areas previously damaged by the roof, skillfully removed hundreds of pounds of legacy debris from the attic and then insulated the attic. It has been a very busy time, and we are grateful the Lord blessed and it came out well.
