MINISTRY UPDATE

As we conclude the fourth quarter of 2025, we are grateful to report the Lord's continued blessing on the work of Global Baptist Church Planters. During this quarter, we had the opportunity to present the ministry in churches across the Midwest and Southeast. Through these meetings, several churches committed to begin supporting GBCP, strengthening our partnership base and expanding our ability to invest in new church plants around the world.

Because of this increased support, we were able to approve funding for 52 new church plants in 2025, bringing our total to 908 church plants supported—placing us within striking distance of our goal of 1,000 churches planted by the end of 2027. We were also encouraged to complete the support terms for nearly 40 church plants this year. It has been a blessing to see these churches finish their journey with us, remove the metaphorical training wheels, and continue forward as self-sufficient, self-governing, Independent Baptist churches. Across our supported church plants in 2025, God allowed us to see more than 50,000 souls saved and over 10,000 believers baptized. We rejoice in what the Lord accomplished this year, and we give Him all the glory.

As we look ahead to 2026, our prayer is simple: more—more churches started, more souls saved, more communities reached, and more believers in the United States challenged to play their part in fulfilling the Great Commission. With that vision in mind, we are thrilled to announce our first-ever Global Church Planting Day, taking place on Friday, January 30, streaming live on Facebook and YouTube from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. EST. Our prayer is that this event will give pastors and laymen alike a deeper understanding of the work of the Gospel around the world and provide a clear path for personal involvement in global church planting.

In December, the Lord guided us through the Christmas season as we reached people living on the roadside by distributing blankets and providing food to nearly 100 needy individuals. Above all, our focus remained on proclaiming the Gospel. As we celebrated the birth of our Savior, we shared the message of Jesus Christ and conducted special Christmas programs in different villages where the Gospel was preached and people were encouraged with the hope of salvation.
