Cuba - Building for the Future

Our travels this quarter took us back to Cuba, where we've been walking alongside our brothers and sisters through a vital leadership transition. Transitions can often be challenging and emotional, yet we have seen God's hand guiding every step. We are so thankful for the wisdom and foresight our fellow servants demonstrated in preparing for the future. The Lord has blessed Cuba with faithful, committed leaders who love Him deeply and serve His people with dedication. Our planning meetings together were not only productive but truly refreshing to the soul. We left encouraged, energized, and full of anticipation for what God will do in the days ahead.



Malawi - The Gospel on the Move

This past quarter, I had the incredible privilege of returning to Malawi with Evangelist Toru Marshall. In just nine days, we were able to minister to nearly 3,000 people, and by God's grace, 2,122 of them professed Christ as their Savior. These numbers aren't just statistics; they represent lives eternally changed by the power of the Gospel.







We began our trip in Blantyre with a three-day conference that drew people from 120 churches across Malawi. It was a beautiful sight, believers from every corner of the country coming together to encourage one another, lift their voices in worship, and be fed from the Word of God. I had the joy of training pastors in Proper Biblical Interpretation and guiding all the attendees through what it truly means to be a disciple of Jesus. Each evening, Brother Toru preached a clear, Spirit-filled Gospel message, and we witnessed many come to Christ right there in those meetings.

After the conference, we traveled to two different villages for two days of intensive ministry. Our plan was simple but powerful: spend the day preaching the Gospel, teaching about the church, and end the evening with the *Jesus Film* in Chichewa, followed by a straightforward Gospel invitation from Brother Toru.

The first day began strong, and we had 680 people gathered under the sun to hear the Word. Toru presented the Gospel with boldness, and I taught on the biblical foundation of the church. But as the afternoon wore on, the air turned colder. By sunset, the chill was sharp enough that people began drifting away to warm themselves by fires. We didn't get to show the *Jesus Film*, yet God still moved mightily; 522 people made decisions for Christ through the preaching and teaching earlier that day.



The second day brought a dramatic shift. We were in a lower-elevation area where the sun shone brightly, and a gentle breeze kept the air comfortable. This time, we were able to carry out our whole program, teaching and preaching through the day. As the sun set, we began the *Jesus Film*, and the people stood captivated by the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. When Brother Toru gave the invitation, the response was overwhelming. We were able to minister to close to 1,700 people that day and see over two-thirds of them profess Christ as their Savior.

Malawi continues to be a place where hearts are wide open to the Gospel. It is a blessing beyond words to serve alongside faithful believers who labor tirelessly to reach their people with the hope found only in Jesus. Please keep these new believers in your prayers and remember the pastors and churches now following up with them. The harvest is plentiful, the fields are white, and the Gospel is truly on the move in Malawi.
