Dear Fellow Laborers in the Gospel,

As we look back over 2023 as a year of mountains and valleys,

- 1. In 2023 the First Baptist Church celebrating its 65th anniversary of gospel ministry,
- 2. 50th year in Christian education, Milford of Christian Academy Day School,
- 3. 50 years in bible publishing, Bearing Precious Seed,
- 4. 50 years with Master Ministries.

It also in 2023 found us also calling our new pastor; Rev. Edward Barclay III. He's only the third pastor at FBC in the last 55 years; Pastors *Keen, Duttry,* and now *Barclay*.

Another mountain peak event in 2023 for us was the announcement of a new phase to our Bible printing ministry, the establishment of the Whole Bible Division. I want to put more emphasis on the production of whole Bibles in the coming years. We do not want to reduce the production of John/Romans and New Testaments but add the Whole Bible Ministry to what we are already doing.

Why are we adding a WHOLE BIBLE DIVISION to our production schedule?

- 1. Because God has increased our production capabilities at BPS.
- 2. There is more detailed information about God in the Old Testament than in the New Testament. If our goal is to introduce a pagan world to the true God, the more information we can give the pagans the better off we are.
- 3. We believe the assignment of the missionaries is not only soul-winning but also church planting and it's highly unlikely we can plant many churches if we don't have the whole Bible.
- 4. I would like to see us increase our goals *from* printing partial Bibles (J/R, New Testaments) *for* a partial world (1040 window) to a whole Bible for a whole world. It is true BPS has printed some whole Bibles, but it is also true it's a tiny percentage (-2%) of the 230 million of our total production since '73.

My personal valley in '23 was a health issue. That took me out of the pulpit for seven months.
