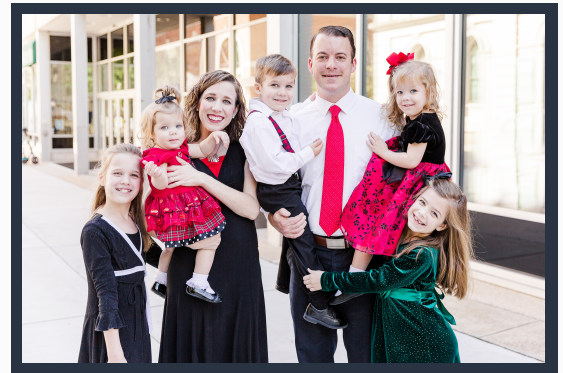
We are thankful for two children (one of them being our own Madison) being baptized in October! We use an inflatable jacuzzi in our foyer for the baptisms.
