SERVING OUR LORD- THE GOD OF THE LIVING, NOT THE DEAD

Here in Mexico, the last week of October and first week of November are dedicated to Halloween and the Day of the Dead. In fact, in Hispanic culture many have a reverential respect for, or even worship "el Dios de la Muerte"- a skeletal figure, often a woman, robed in black and carrying a large harvesting sickle. There is great spiritual oppression. However, this also presents us with an opportunity to share the gospel and address the difficult issues of witchcraft, spirits, death, and the afterlife. We appreciate your prayers as we battle the forces of evil here on the front lines of Mexico.

We traveled to Chiapas recently to visit Ruth's Mother, a veteran missionary in Mexico for over 65 years, Billie Sloan. Our daughter & her husband also flew there from Brazil. It was such a blessing for Ruth to be there with her mom, daughter, and granddaughter- 4 generations! What a rich heritage. While there Abigail and Stephen shared the wonderful news that they are expecting their second child, a boy! "Yay-men!"

After 5 days we came back to Queretaro to prepare for Mexican Independence Day. We had a Noche Mexicana in our Church. The men and boys preached, and the ladies prepared a delicious traditional Mexican meal. ¡Qué rico!

2 weeks later Ruth and Lizzy traveled to Brazil to speak in a Ladies Conference in our Son-in-Law's Church. There were over 350 ladies present.



October was "Missions Month" for our Church. We focused on world-wide evangelism and giving via Faith Promise. During this time, I preached on our duty to spread the Gospel, and the Church divided into 8 teams representing the countries of the missionaries we currently support. The decorations were awesome & the spirit and participation was great. We also had a missionary family to Brazil present their ministry. On the last Sunday of the month, we took up our Faith Promise Commitment- almost \$2000 dollars a month-very generous for our small Church, & more than I expected. Praise the Lord. This will allow us to continue to support our current missionaries and take on more throughout the next year. Concluding the service the ladies prepared an International Meal which was the perfectly scrumptious way to celebrate this great victory.

Obviously, the devil was not happy with our spiritual focus, so, unfortunately, we have also experienced some intense spiritual opposition. We had to address an issue between some ladies in the Church related to gossip, and sadly, one of those ladies decided to quit, taking her 3 children with her. Additionally, I had an accident that required a trip to the emergency room, 16 stitches, and a \$500 bill. Ouch!
