That describes the last 6 weeks of our ministry here in Mexico! We started the new Church "Iglesia Bautista Fidelidad" (Faithfulness Baptist Church) on July 16. One person attended, a young lady, Georgina. She was saved during our previous ministry years earlier (she was 13). She got away from the Lord and married an unsaved young man, Danny. Danny is a great guy- a hard worker and very polite. He has started coming now. Pray for him as he is unsure about his soul. I think He will be saved soon. I also think the Lord has a special ministry for this precious family.

Since our start 7 weeks ago, we have had a few other families attend that have heard about the new Church. **We have had a high day of 32 so far!**

Please pray for a new ministry we started in the same hospital where our son, Jonathan, passed away 17 years ago. We were able to get permission from the administration to do this on the property, which was itself a miracle. **We have been able to reach a dozen people for Christ in the past month as a result of this ministry.**

3 weeks ago we had a downpour on a Wednesday night during Church. 2 young people- Brenda and JianCarlo-(brother & sister) stepped inside the Church to get out of the rain. They stayed and listened until the end. Afterwards, Ruth and I gave them the gospel. Turns out, Brenda had wanted to commit suicide the day before, because the city had taken away her kids the week prior. She was distraught. After hearing about Christ's love, she and her brother BOTH got saved! All because a rainstorm drove them to enter a Bible preaching Baptist Church! Praise the Lord!
