College Expansion

We continue to expand our video classes beyond Monrovia and into surrounding villages. We are presently in Faith Baptist Church in Thinker Village. We have just added Great Commission Baptist Church in Compound, pastored by one of our students, Samuel Paye. We will be adding another location at the beginning of next year. Each expansion requires a computer, projector, screen, and sometimes a generator. *We can use some assistance in getting these necessary tools.*

New Church Plant

We are moving forward with a church plant in the village of Saclapea. Ayres Voyee has been a student in our college from the beginning and serving as assistant to Pastor Emmanuel Saywah at Faith Baptist Church. He is ready to return to his home area and start a church. We have located a 3-acre piece of land that will allow us to build a church and provide farming for their livelihood. *We need \$10,000 for the purchase of this property.*
