The visa renewals for my colleagues and me have been complicated this year. I started the process back in July and have had to pay for expensive "extensions," but still do not have the renewal. Please pray that it is approved soon before I have to pay for another "extension."

Uganda has been on alert for terrorist attacks. In September, the police thwarted a suicide bomber attack at a mega church in Kampala, Uganda. This is an Islamic State rebel group from the Congo. Earlier this year, they attacked a school in Kasese, Uganda, brutally killing 41 children and taking some captive. A few weeks ago, they killed two tourists and their guide in a game park in Uganda. Our national pastor spoke to some local Muslims who were discussing the war in Israel. One of them said the Israelites and Christians should be killed. Normally the Muslims in Soroti seem peaceful, and our people have led some Muslims to the Lord. I know some of the Muslim countries have called for Jihad worldwide because of the war between Israel and Hamas, and violence around the world is increasing. The president here has warned churches to be careful; otherwise, praise the Lord, we are safe. I pray God keeps you all safe. **Bless the Lord who redeemeth thy life from destruction.**
