We have some things to share. Some great and some not as exciting. We are looking forward to see how the Lord uses all of this. I want to share the good stuff first and ask that you pray with us about the other.

First of all, when we wrote last, Harold Simon had passed away. That was my first funeral in the bush. We had been praying for his lost loved ones to be saved. God answered that prayer! In October while we were in the interior, his daughter Tasha let my wife and I share scriptures with her for an hour and a half. That evening she asked Christ to forgive her to be her Savior. She was so happy and so were we! Immediately we connected her with some friends that started taking her to church. The first week was their missions conference and she attended every service!

Secondly, we finally met a 7-year goal! We have wanted an updated video that would explain the ministry, both summer and winter. After we heard about Lens Of The Harvest ministry, we began 2 years of dialog and videoing during three trips around the state. The goal was to have a video that other missionaries could use as well. Janet has spent evenings with mom as required. My goal is to have my wife and children travel with me to supporting churches while down here.

Lastly, we plan to be in the lower 48 until sometime in May. We have been assured that the ministry will be maintained over the winter. Two men at the church in Anchorage who have LOTS of experience traveling with us and using our equipment have committed to take all of this responsibility off of my shoulders so that we could be out for the winter. Five years ago when we were out, we didn't make it to many of our supporting churches.
