The boys came to us and said, "We need stuff like that every week". They said we were the only ones that had come back in since covid. One of the boys said, "I haven't got what you guys have got." The next night he came back out and got saved!


Hardeman County in Whiteville, Tennessee is an 1,800-man prison with a lot of lost souls in it. We had a three-day revival with 14 men saved on visitation and in the services. I met Jason, a 41 year-old, who told me his brother had just passed away in February and he was having a real hard time with it. As I talked with him I asked him if he knew the Lord. He told me no and to the best of his knowledge neither did his brother. I asked him if through all of this if he thought that God was drawing him and he told me he knew He was. Then I asked him if he wanted to get saved the old fashioned Bible way and he said, "Yes"! So Jason prayed and told God he was a wicked sinner and asked for forgiveness and cleansing so he could go to God's heaven.

In another unit I met Christopher, a 42 year-old. He had been in for three years on a six-year sentence for drugs. As we talked he told me he was not saved and not doing right in or out of prison. I told him what he needed was Jesus Christ and His salvation. Then as we talked some more and I told him that Jesus is the One we sin against when we sin and that sin keeps us out of Heaven. I told him we must come to Jesus as a little child and ask for His forgiveness and cleansing from our sin. That is just what Christopher did! He bowed his head and prayed in his own words. He asked the LORD to forgive him and save him!
