Dear Pastor, Church, and Friends,

We praise God for the **99** salvations and **4** baptisms for the months of July and August. Forty-six of those salvations were from the Vacation Bible School we had in July. We had three days of VBS. A total of 582 children and teens came for the VBS with an average of 194 attending each day. We heard from a grandmother, the following, "My granddaughter came home excited from VBS. She said, 'Granny, they spoke about sin and said to me, Granny, I was going to hell, but not anymore! Cause, I prayed and accepted Jesus in my heart. Now, I'm going to Heaven.'"

The theme for the VBS was Showers of Blessings – Ez. 34:26. Each day we started the opening assembly with songs about God's blessings. We used these songs - There Shall be Showers of Blessings, A Faithful Man Shall Abound with Blessings – scripture song (Prov. 28:20). We also used other Sunday school children's songs for the different days. These songs were used: Hey, Hey, Captain Jack; I'm Singing in the Rain Since Jesus Came; Which Side are You Singing On?; I Will Magnify the Lord; I've Been Redeemed; I'm In-right, Out-right, Up-right, Down-right, Happy All the Time. As an activity in the opening assembly, we had the making of a rain storm by the children rubbing their fingertips together, snapping their fingers, slapping their legs, and stomping their feet. Everybody loved this activity. Each day we also had a puppet skit with Charles and Riff-Raff and the case of the missing toy.

During our VBS, we received news that one of our most faithful prayer warriors passed away. My mother, who was 89 years of age, graduated to Heaven. Mother was used of God to lead me toward Christ in November of 1978. She was a tremendous soulwinner at her church in Brooklyn, New York, for many years. At her funeral seven people received Christ as their Savior.

Some have asked if I am completely recovered from the stroke I had in January of 2024. Yes, praise the Lord. I have made a very significant, if not a complete recovery. There are still some problems with memory at times, but only temporary. I would like to thank all of you who have prayed for me. You are all such wonderful people. We could not do what we do here on the mission field, if it were not for all of you. The power of prayer is evident. Our prayers are often for you. We praise God for answering prayers.

A young medical student recently completed the third level of the Foundations of My Faith Discipleship Program.

In August there was teen camp and many attended from over a dozen Independent Baptist churches. Sound Bible preaching stirred the hearts of the teens.

We look forward to the annual Faith Promise Missions Conference in the ending part of October. Please pray with us for God to call forth more workers for the ripened fields.

Thank you for the part you have in this work in Guyana.
