Adoptions

We have been told that the final papers for Natalia's adoption were sent from the court to social services for one more signature. We are praying to hear soon that we have a court date.

Two other children who have lived with us for 10 years are available for adoption. We have started the paperwork for Victor and Heidy. They informed us last week that a new law is in effect, requiring our bank statement and marriage license to be notarized and apostilled. So, we have sent for this paperwork. Please join us in prayer that the paperwork is returned promptly and that God will provide the necessary funds for these two adoptions.

School

We are grateful for the 54 students in our school. We have been diligent in fulfilling all government requirements. However, they say we need another teacher with a degree to teach English subjects. Additionally, we have one Honduran teacher leaving, so we need either a full-time Honduran teacher or two part-time teachers. I say Honduran because a teacher from any other country cannot teach the Spanish subjects. We had a teacher with good degrees from Venezuela, but they would not allow her to work here.

We need an English teacher from another country if anyone is interested! A degree in education or sociology would be good. If you would like to spend a few months or even an entire school year on a mission field, we would like to hear from you! Please consider what the Lord could possibly do with and for you in Honduras. We can only pay a little; our part-time teachers usually start at L5500 per month.

In November, we focused on thankfulness in Civics and Bible time. The week before Thanksgiving, we started each morning with a Bible story of thankfulness, ending with a message of salvation. A few students are asking questions. Please pray for them. Dawn often reminds our teachers, yes, we are here to give these students a quality education, but our vision is that they might all be saved.

Our Alicia was diagnosed with Scoliosis this month, and we are praying for her to return to the States to get better medical help. We would appreciate your prayers for her!
