Psalm 119:165 "Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them."

Dear Fellow Labourers in Christ,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ!

Psalm 119, the crown jewel of the Psalmist, with 176 verses extolling the sufficiency and supremacy of God's Word, gives us this truth in verse 165—a verse of clarity, comfort, and conviction.

This verse, nestled in the longest chapter in the Bible—an ode to God's Word—stands as a lighthouse to the storm-tossed soul.

In a generation overwhelmed by unrest—socially, politically, spiritually—this verse shines like a lighthouse. In an age of anxiety, where mental distress and spiritual instability are rampant, Psalm 119:165 offers a divine antidote: Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

It does not merely offer peace, but great peace. It promises stability, not in ease, but in adversity. The world is constantly shaken, but God's Word anchors the soul. This verse is not a poetic suggestion, but a spiritual declaration.

This "great peace" is not given to all, but a **particular group**—a spiritual remnant. This promise is **conditional**, not universal. It belongs to a **specific class of saints**, not to every casual reader. This eliminates the carnal or half-hearted, the faithless and mediocre—only the committed reap this peace.

The old Welsh Baptist revivalist, Howell Harris said: *"Where the Word of God is loved and obeyed, there is a joy and quietness that neither man nor devil can disturb."*

When we are consumed by the Word of God, even when offence arises—whether before us or against us—great peace prevails, enabling us to remain steadfast and sure. Praise God for His perfect, preserved, purified, and precious Word, our sole authority and unshakable foundation.
