## **Summer Training Internship**

Another summer season has come and gone, and we are grateful for the opportunities that the Lord gave us this year to work with a top-notch group of young men who are all preparing for future ministry and mission field service. It's an honor for us to have this small part in their lives, and we're excited to see how and where the Lord uses them in the days and years ahead.

This summer, *Noah Brown* and *David White* both earned their commercial pilot certificates; *Micah Weldy* earned his Instrument Rating; and *Rob Parsons* (missionary to *Columbia*) will be finishing up his private pilot certificate this month. All together, we safely flew nearly 275 flight hours during the program with minimal downtime for routine inspections and servicing, thanks to our tremendous aircraft maintenance staff.

In addition to their flight training, students gained hands-on experience in aircraft maintenance tasks, received excellent Biblical counsel and practical ministry teaching from veteran missionaries who participated in our program, and had opportunities to be involved in the local church ministries.






