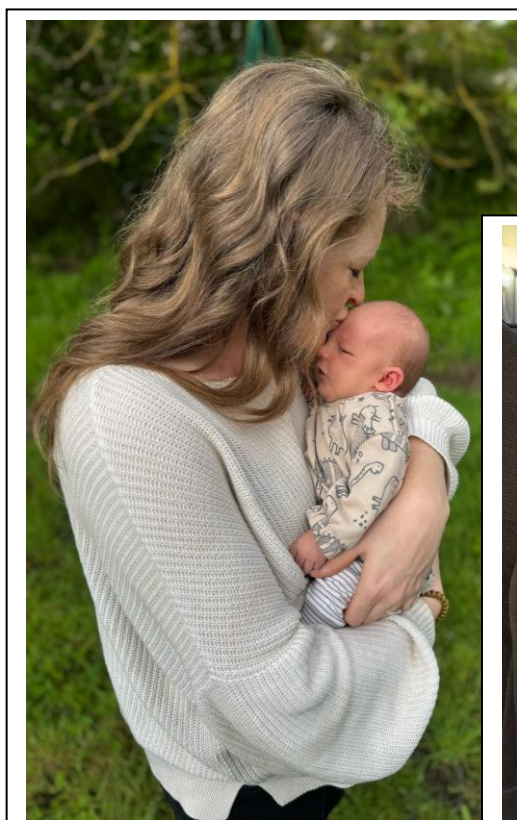
Dear friends in Christ,

Two of our radio stations were inspected by the government and we were approved to transmit 10 more years on these two stations. We are waiting for paperwork (government approval) for our license to transmit in two other cities. During this time, we have constructed two towers that are built, painted, and ready to be shipped to the site. We are prepared to move forward once we receive the final approval to put two more stations in place.

On one Saturday I held an all-day conference a southern city in Peru (Curshuasi) and preached there the next Sunday. The following week I traveled to the city of Tacna located on the border with Chile. I spent two full days there ministering to nine pastors in the morning. Then in the evening their wives joined us, and I taught for two hours with a break in between. These were fantastic opportunities to help pastors and churches.

Do you remember we were fined when we cut the branches off a tree that sits up against our property wall. The roots of the tree were blocking our sewer lines, and we had to also trim back the tree. The fine was a heavy one. We appealed and about 2 years later, we won the appeal over such an insignificant matter where we were actually helping the tree (the authorities call the tree "the individual"). Praise the Lord this is all behind us.
