Camps and Opportunities Coming

Summer is soon upon us and that means camping season. Last year we presented the opportunity to give an offering that would be a partial scholarship to help needy children and large families attend our camp just outside Lima. We would like to present to you the same need once again.

A week at camp costs about \$28. We want to offer a scholarship that would cover a little bit less than half that amount. This makes it affordable for many parents to send their children to camp while at the same time it still requires a sacrifice on their part. The sacrifice makes them appreciate the opportunity to attend camp and the scholarship provides an opportunity for others to give and be a blessing to children and reap eternal rewards for the glory of our Lord. We encourage church people here in Lima to give financially for scholarships as well.

The scholarship also helps to sustain costs at camp. This year our goal is to provide 350 scholarships. This would be a goal of \$9,800 (\$28 x 350 campers).
