This was the fourth and final month that we have visited supporting churches on this trip. In October we visited churches in Ohio and one in Maryland.

On Wednesday, October 29, we fly back to Peru. We are sending this letter out to you so that you can be praying for our safe return. We are just hours away from departing.

It has been such an encouragement to see many of you! What a precious time in the Lord! Your love, prayers, and support through all these years is a constant reminder of our Lord's grace and provision. We just praise the Lord for His working in all of you and return to Peru overflowing with gratitude to all of you for your kindness and generosity to us! It was an amazing time connecting with our friends. Partnering together in the great commission over many years has been a precious relationship.

During our time here in the U.S. we were able to visit 30 of our supporting churches. We were also invited to share about our ministry on a Wednesday night in another church and were in several conferences. Ruth and I also team taught in Christian day schools. In all, we reported to more than half of our supporting churches. We have 19 more to visit. God willing we will try to visit them in the fall of 2026. With the interruption of COVID, it had been 7 years since we were able to visit most of you.

For those we were not able to visit this year, if you would like us to visit you in the months of September, October or early November in 2026, please let us know and we will do our best to make that happen. We thank you for your patience in waiting for another year.

While traveling, I (Stan) was able to do our daily live radio broadcast each morning Monday through Friday. I give a short devotional that airs live and then is repeated later in the day. Sometimes I had to do it over the phone in the car while Ruth drove us to our next meeting. Ruth did almost all the driving to our meetings while I worked in the car beside her. What a blessing she is! I could not do half of what I do without her!

A lot of progress has been made in two major projects: the construction of a new radio station in the city of Tumbes (close to Ecuador) and the construction of our multi-purpose ministry property where Ruth and I live in Lima. We are always moving forward with new projects. The Lord is blessing in about every direction, and it is exciting!

God willing, our next letter will be from Peru. Thank you, thank you, thank you for all you do for us. We are humbled by your kindness, honored to be your missionaries, and grateful to be serving our wonderful Lord. What a Savior!
