We are very grateful for the professionals that the Lord brought into our path along with sweet friends that were an encouragement in many ways. Due to her CHARGE syndrome, Alainey's retinas were beginning to tear in both eyes and needed immediate attention. It became a "high priority", considering she is deaf and her vision is essential for her future. This delayed our return to Africa slightly but, we trusted the Lord was in control. We are thankful to report the eye surgery was a complete success we will return home to Africa on September 15th! We eagerly anticipate what the Lord will do in this upcoming term!

Missions Conference

Our home church's missions conference was held during our time in the States. Noah had the oppurtunity to preach the opening service. God has used our local church in the last 3 years to see 7 of our own people sent into foreign missions and 1 sent locally.
