John 1:30 - One who comes after me is greater than me because he comes before me.

God the Artist communicates to us first, before God the lecturer. — Makoto Fujimura, *Art and Faith*

1 Corinthians 1:2 - together with all those everywhere who call on the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Every instance of “you” in this passage is plural (you all).

The movement of the Spirit of God in the hearts of men and women often calls them to act against the spirit of their times. — Howard Thurman

3. Jesus is always \_\_\_\_\_.

God is the primary actor — in Scripture, in our lives.

1 Corinthians 1:8 - He will keep you firm to the end.
