DEFINITION OF REPENTANCE

A change of mind involving both a turning from sin and a turning to God.

Not just the will but the **DESIRE** to change; to turn from sin.

Key Point to Caring for Our Souls:

Is to admit to ourselves and others

And that's why Jesus came to set me free

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REVIEW—Session 4

FROM ORPHAN SPIRIT TO ADOPTIVE CHILD

An *Orphan Spirit* holds their <u>PBS</u> as the absolute truth.

To become an *Adoptive Child*, we must repent of our <u>PBS</u>, not merely the behaviors resulting from it.

It is *our PBS*, we need to accept responsibility of (*not for*), and seek God's healing.

In looking at the 20 differences between an <u>Orphan Spirit</u> and being an <u>Adoptive Child</u> (see Session 4 workbook, pages 3-8); it is <u>we</u> who need to break free and move from the Orphan to Child with God's help.

FORGIVENESS AND RESTORATION

"Forgiveness" does not mean "Agreement"

Forgiveness is Unilateral.

Restoration is Bi-Lateral.

Forgiveness is a Choice.

Restoration is a Process.

Forgiveness is Always possible.

Restoration is sometimes Not possible.

Forgiveness does not automatically restore Trust.

Restoration is a process that requires Time & Trust.

Come after me... Follow where Jesus leads Take up his cross... To follow takes effort Following involves: Daily denial of self

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SESSION 8—THE IMPACTS OF FREEDOM

NOT FREE TO BE ME, BUT FREE TO BE HIS

Sources of Bondage that Prevent Following:

Primarily the atmosphere we grew up in that was normal to us but was <u>neither</u> safe nor normal.

Sin Patterns are <u>Generational</u> in nature and can <u>Entrench</u> and <u>Manifest</u> themselves generation after generation.

Examples being: Addictive patterns - alcohol, sex, anger, conflict (stuffing/exploding)

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SESSION 8—THE IMPACTS OF FREEDOM

OUR FAMILY MODEL—NEGOTIATION

Enhances human relationships

- We are not satisfied in our negotiations until we have both won.
- We trust each other's purpose and motivation, even when we disagree.

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OUR FAMILY MODEL—PRODUCT OF OUR ENVIRONMENT

- 1. The model we have for family is the model that we have seen for family.
 - a) Does the model work?
 - b) Why am I still Using it?
 - c) Are there things that I still believe about myself that come from that model?
 - d) More is caught than taught.
 - e) Is my life still a reaction to the model my family employed?

OUR FAMILY MODEL—PRODUCT OF OUR ENVIRONMENT

2. What if we are talking about more than nurture, DNA, and behavioral modification?

- a) Could it be that you have come up against the very same spirits that have plagued your family for generations?
- b) Curses are a Biblical concept.
- c) Evil Spirits are one third of angels that fell with Satan in his rebellion against God (Rev. 12:3-9).
- d) If God loves the family, wouldn't Satan hate what God loves?

OUR FAMILY MODEL—BREAKING PATTERNS

- 1. Admit the Sin Pattern
- 2. Don't Compromise

Deal with <u>Unforgiveness</u>, it is <u>Self-destructive</u> and is a **Stronghold** of the enemy.

Breaking the Curses of the Family Line

- 1. Remember and recognize family patterns.
- 2. Confess those that were sinful.
- 3. Submit to God.

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SESSION 8—THE IMPACTS OF FREEDOM

BREAKING THE CURSES OF THE FAMILY LINE

4. Submit to God using this prayer:

"Heavenly Father, I submit to you in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and I confess that I have given place to evil spirits of my forefathers. I ask You to forgive me for my sins and the sins of my forefathers as they have stood against me. I renounce all bondage from my lineage and proclaim my new lineage is through the shed Blood of the Lord Jesus Christ. I proclaim that I am a child of God. I ask You to free me from all bondage from my lineage passed down to me from my father and mother back to the third and fourth generation, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ."

(Deuteronomy 5:9; Numbers 14:18)

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Breaking the Curses of the Family Line

5. Declare to the familiar spirits and satanic assignments:

"I come against all evil spirits of the lineage of my father and my mother back to the third and fourth generation and I break your hold over me in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. I have submitted to my God and have claimed my new lineage in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ and you cannot stay. I rebuke you in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and I command you to leave my mind and my flesh and go directly to the pit of hell right now, in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ. I break all spoken and unspoken curses, and I command all evil spirits from curses to go straight to the pit of hell right now in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ."

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SESSION 8—THE IMPACTS OF FREEDOM

BREAKING THE CURSES OF THE FAMILY LINE
6. In faith, thank the Lord Jesus Christ for your victory.



Breaking the Curses of the Family Line

7. Be filled with the Holy Spirit—

In prayer invite the Holy Spirit to occupy and take control of all areas that were controlled by the enemy. The filling of the Holy Spirit is in direct proportion to your surrender.

Ephesians 5:18 says, "....be filled with the Spirit."

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SESSION 8—THE IMPACTS OF FREEDOM

CONCLUSION: "MOSES A TRANSFORMED MAN"

Moses was not:

"a thing which came out of the water"

Moses was:

- a Man who stuttered
- a Man who wondered where he belonged
- a Man who murdered
- a Man who ran for his life
- a Man who heard God's voice from the bush

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SESSION 8—THE IMPACTS OF FREEDOM

CONCLUSION: "MOSES A TRANSFORMED MAN"

Moses was also:

a Man who said:

"If you do not go with me I will not go."

a Man who said:

"I want to see your glory."

a Man who experienced God's presence as a man speaks face to face with a friend

The Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Exodus 33:11

SOUL HEALING PRINCIPLES

- 1. God isn't trying to fix us; He is trying to restore us.
- 2. Theology 101—God is smart, and He knows stuff we don't know, and He likes to tell us.
- 3. Tell your story.
- 4. Emotional healing takes place by seeking God's presence in the <u>Memory</u> of the hurt, feeling his healing in <u>Solitude</u> and <u>Silence</u>, but then living out his healing in <u>Community</u>.
