*Call to Worship:

Pastor: The time is coming— when God will not remain silent, when the fire beneath the pot will burn hot, and all that has been hidden will come to light.

Congregation: We come before the God who sees and knows, who purifies and restores what has been corrupted.

Pastor: The time is coming— when judgment and mercy meet, when God’s refining fire will cleanse and renew His people.

Congregation: We come not to hide from the flame, but to be made whole by the One who redeems through fire.

Pastor: The time is coming— when the Lord will act, and all will know that He is God.

All: So we gather in awe and hope, trusting the God who burns away impurity, and brings forth new life. The time is coming— and the time is now.

Opening Prayer:

Holy and righteous God, You are the One who sees clearly, who looks beneath the surface of our lives and exposes what lies within. You are the refiner’s fire— burning away what is false, cleansing what has been corrupted, and calling Your people to holiness.

We confess that we often resist Your fire. We want Your comfort without Your correction, Your blessing without Your refining. But today, Lord, we open ourselves to You. We ask You to purify our hearts, to stir what has grown cold, and to renew our passion for Your will and Your way.

May this time of worship draw us nearer to Your truth. May Your Spirit move among us with grace and power. And may we leave this place changed— ready to live as people who know that the time is coming, and the time is now.

In the name of Jesus Christ, our hope and our redemption, we pray. Amen.

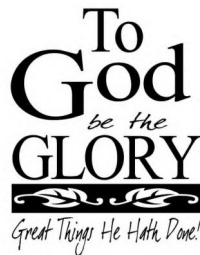
A bright and safe nursery is available for your child through age 4 if needed during worship and the Sunday school/Discipleship Hour.

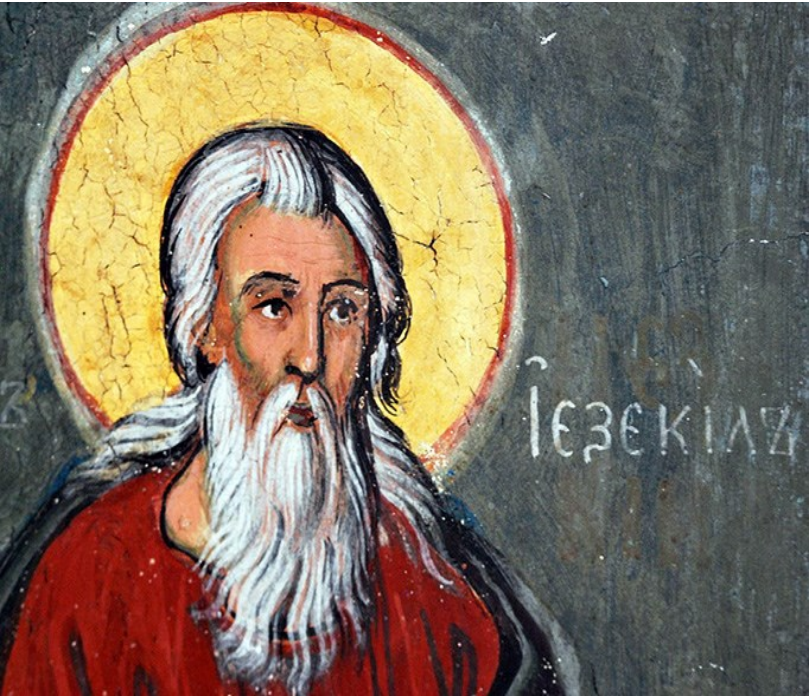
