Students are encouraged to journal key insights, questions, and applications from their reading which will be discussed in the following session. The Bible is our ultimate authority, and this practice helps students grow in their knowledge of the Word and their walk with Christ.

Book Readings

Alongside the Bible, carefully chosen books by trusted Christian authors provide practical instruction on servanthood, leadership, prayer, evangelism, and walking in the Spirit. These readings complement Scripture and foster thoughtful discussion, deeper understanding, and personal growth. Students are expected to complete the readings before class and come prepared to share insights and applications in class.

Attendance & Participation

Consistent attendance is an important part of spiritual growth and ministry training and is essential for the completion of the course. Each session builds upon the last, and being present allows students to benefit fully from teaching, discussion, and fellowship. Students are expected to attend and participate regularly, and serve in some capacity in the ministries of Calvary Chapel Hudson Valley. If an absence is necessary, it should be communicated in advance whenever possible. Please note that more than four absences may hinder successful completion of the program.

<u>Sermons</u>

Throughout the year, students will hear topical sermons taught by different pastors and ministry leaders. These messages will focus on ministry, serving others, and walking closely with the Lord. Hearing from a variety of teachers will help students see the many ways God works through His people and will encourage them to grow in both faith and service. Students are expected to take notes during these sermons so they can reflect, review, and apply what they have learned.

This School of Ministry is not simply about gaining information, but about experiencing transformation. Our desire is that every lesson, every reading, every testimony, and every time of prayer will draw students closer to Jesus and shape them into His likeness.
