## **USING YOUR EPHESIANS GUIDE**

We are so excited to study the book of Ephesians together! Throughout this series, we hope you will engage with the book of Ephesians as we gather on Sunday mornings and throughout the week. This guide is meant to help you go deeper in your daily time with God as you study His word and respond to Him through prayer.

Each week in this guide, you'll find a daily reading plan that includes the Scripture we're studying that week and other helpful passages. Space is provided for you to write your observations, applications, prayers, and sermon notes. We encourage you to make this a part of your daily time with God and to approach His word devotionally, not just academically.

Throughout our series, we would also like to challenge everyone in our church family to memorize the passage below. How amazing would it be if these truths were on our minds and written on our hearts throughout the day? We hope to see this book make a difference in our day-to-day lives and ultimately conform us to who God desires us to be in Christ.

### **EPHESIANS 4:17 - 5:2**

So this I say, and affirm together with the Lord, that you walk no longer just as the Gentiles also walk, in the futility of their mind, 18 being darkened in their understanding, excluded from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the hardness of their heart; 19 and they, having become callous, have given themselves over to sensuality for the practice of every kind of impurity with greediness. 20 But you did not learn Christ in this way, 21 if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught in Him, just as truth is in Jesus, 22 that, in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit, 23 and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind, 24 and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth.

# INTRODUCTION

## THE SOAP METHOD

We will be using the SOAP method of Bible study each week. It's a simple way of studying God's word that doesn't require a seminary degree or Greek language skills! It will encourage you to slow down and dig deeper as you study the book of Ephesians. "SOAP" is an acronym for Scripture, Observation, Application, and Prayer. This method will help you avoid glossing over essential truths in God's word, and it will help you apply His truths to your life.



## S - Scripture

Physically write out the Bible verse. This will help you slow down and take note of things you might not otherwise observe.



#### O - Observation

Write down everything that stands out to you - people, places, repetition of words, main ideas, or key themes.



## A - Application

Is there a direct challenge from the text for me to apply? What other truths can I apply from the text? What changes do I need to make?



## P - Prayer

Spend time praising God for who He is, confessing any known sin, thanking Him for the blessings in your life, and asking him to provide for your needs.
