Introduction

- 1. The King is Revealed (vv. 1-7)
 - A. Jesus plans to reveal His kingship (vv. 1-3)
 - B. Jesus fulfills prophecy (Matt. 21:4-5)
 - i. Old Testament quotations (Isaiah 62:11, Zechariah 9:9)
 - ii. Exhibits humility and peace (Zech. 9:9-10, 1 Kings 1:33-34)
 - iii. The disciples don't initially understand (John 12:16)
 - C. Jesus' plan is carried out (vv. 4-7)
- 2. The King is Praised (vv.8-10)
 - A. The crowds honor Jesus with cloaks and branches (v. 8)
 - B. The crowds shout praise (v. 9-10; Jn. 12:18; Ps. 118:25-26)

3. The King Enters Jerusalem (v. 11)

- A. The crowds disperse (v. 11a)
- B. Jesus examines the temple and will deliver His verdict soon (v. 11b; Mk. 11:12-25)

4. Conclusion

- A. Don't miss the true mission of King Jesus: to save people from their sins! (Matt. 1:21; Lk. 19:10; Mk. 10:45)
- B. Jesus entered the earth and Jerusalem humbly, but will enter at the end with might to defeat the forces of evil as Kings of Kings and Lord of Lords (Rev. 19:11-16)
