

Drop Off & Pick Up

Your child's safety is of utmost importance to us. Please enter the building using Door #6 on the North side of the parking lot. You will check in your child at the computer kiosks in Park Place upon arrival. Your child will receive a printed name tag for them and a security code tag for you. The person responsible for picking up your child must present this security code tag before your child will be released (a texted photo of the security code tag is acceptable).
