Acts 2:42 ⁴²They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer.

3. Because scripture is clear on why we need community. (C.I.A)


**We need life cheerleaders

Hebrews 10: And let us consider one another in order to provoke love and good works,²⁵ not neglecting to gather together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging each other, and all the more as you see the day approaching.

**We need life instruction/direction

Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell richly among you, in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another through psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs,²⁶ singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

**We need accountability



Galatians 6:1 Brothers and sisters, if someone is overtaken in any wrongdoing, you who are spiritual, restore such a person with a gentle spirit,^[a] watching out for yourselves so that you also won't be tempted. ²Carry one another's burdens; in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. ³ For if anyone considers himself to be something when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

4. Because we can never be our best for Christ until we embrace community

1 Corinthians 12:12 For just as the body is one and has many parts, and all the parts of that body, though many, are one body—so also is Christ. ¹³ For we were all baptized by^[a] one Spirit into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and we were all given one Spirit to drink. ¹⁴ Indeed, the body is not one part but many. ¹⁵ If the foot should say, “Because I'm not a hand, I don't belong to the body,” it is not for that reason any less a part of the body. ¹⁶ And if the ear should say, “Because I'm not an eye, I don't belong to the body,” it is not for that reason any less a part of the body.
