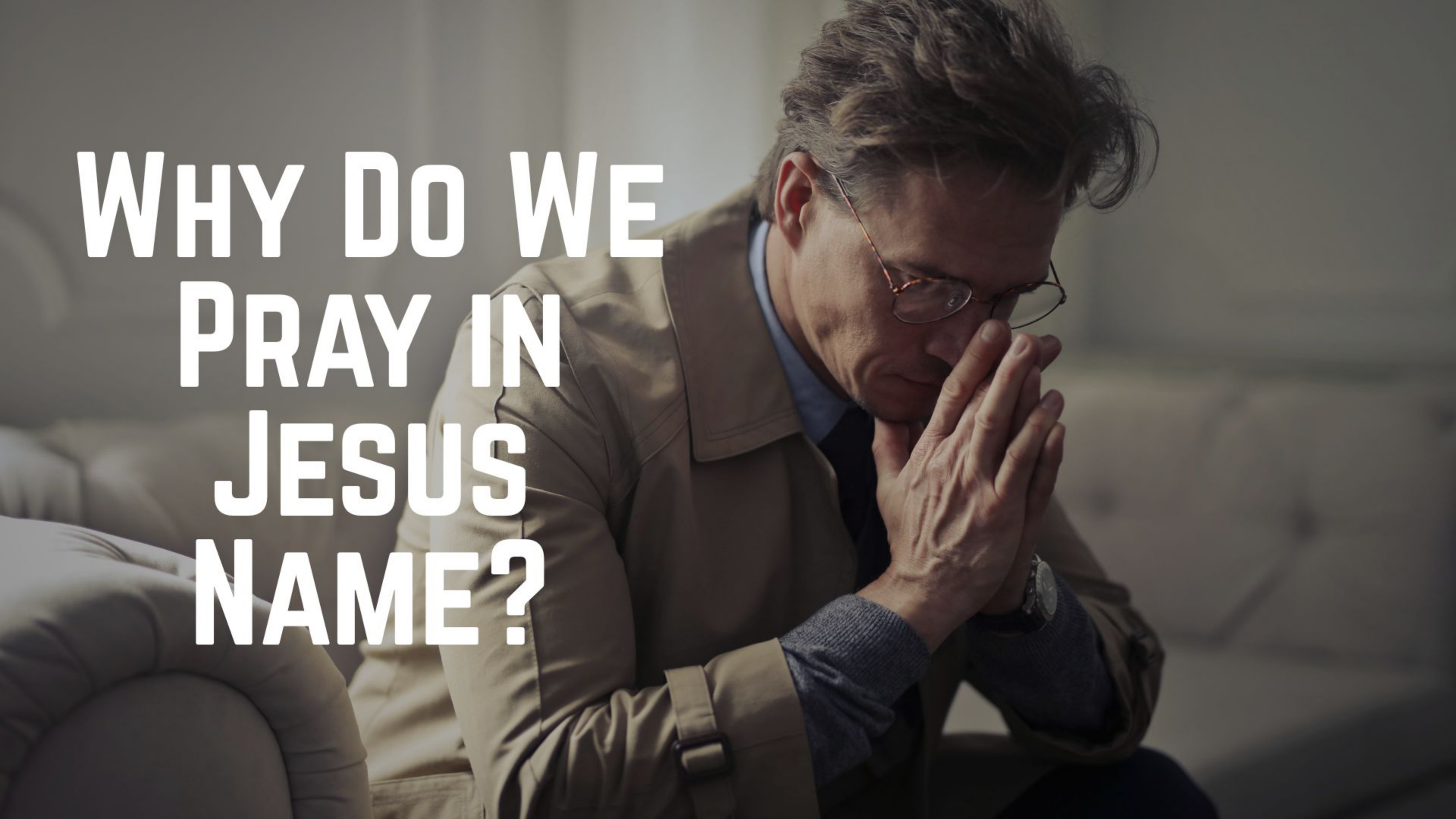


# Name **Above** All Names
