

# A Job Too Big for Michigan Church of God

“Start small. Conquer your closet before you take on the world.” -Byron Tully

A few days ago, Sonja and I drove over to Muskegon, Michigan, to meet with the pastors/spouses on the district in that part of the state. We had a wonderful time with them.

As we were on our way, I noticed a big billboard that showed Smokey Bear with a sad beseeching look on his face. The caption read: “Only You Can Stop Forrest Fires.”

Only me! Really?

Could not others chip in and help? (You know...professionally trained firefighters.)

Do I have to keep an eye on every campfire out there? Is it up to me to stamp out every tossed cigarette and monitor every fireworks show?

And what about lightning-induced fires? Am I responsible for them, too? Honestly, lightning is a bit above my paygrade. (And I’m not even going to discuss volcanic eruptions.)

Was the devastating fire in Los Angeles my fault? All those fires in Canada? What about those huge continually burning forest fires in the Amazon?

The sign said only me.

But dear ole Smokey Bear was lying. It was a well-intentioned lie, and I gladly support the premise behind it and willingly pledge to Smokey Bear that I will do my part, but I will not allow him to put the full responsibility of stopping forest fires on me.

Okay, I know I’m overreacting a bit, but I’m doing so for a purpose.

We often treat other things the same way.

Take the Great Commission, for example. Surely I'm not the only one who has had someone try to make me feel like the salvation of the entire world was my responsibility. If the eternal destination of everyone around me was my responsibility, then to take a break would be to damn some poor soul to hell, to stop to eat would be evil. To finally succumb to exhaustion due to trying to be a faithful witness would mean that a steady stream of souls would be stepping over my exhausted sleeping body as they fell over into hell.

Are we responsible for being a faithful witness? You bet we are.

Do we as individuals and as caring congregations have a vital role in fulfilling the Great Commission in our communities, state, and around the world? Absolutely.

But saving everyone? That's a job that is too big for us.

But before you despair, notice how Jesus breaks down the Great Commission:

1. Jesus has all authority (Matthew 28:18)

2. As we go, we are to make disciples by baptizing them and teaching them the commandments of Jesus (Matthew 28:19-20a)

3. Jesus will be with us to the end of time (Matthew 18:20b)

Did you notice the alpha and the omega? (The beginning and the end?)

It is Jesus. Success is up to him. As we go, we go in his authority and with his presence. In other words, if there's any "saving" going on it will be due to Jesus, not us.

So whether it is stopping forest fires or stopping people from the fires of hell, we all have a role to play. But never forget, only Jesus can save souls (and manage lightning and volcanoes). Keep that clear, represent Jesus well in word & deed, and enjoy the good life God has given you.

That's my advice for all the good people of Michigan Church of God for 2026 and beyond.

## **URGENT**

To facilitate promotions to ordained bishop, ensuring ability to participate in the General Council sessions at the upcoming General Assembly, the date of April 1, 2026, has been set as the deadline to receive candidate applications in the Michigan Church of God State Office. This will allow the mandatory time to complete the process of promotion for these applicants. Please note that these promotions are not complete until the signed certificate is received in Business and Records, and needs to be received no later than April 25, 2026.

Also – any promotions to ordained bishop that require International Executive Council approval in the April session must be received no later than March 1, 2026. This would also be true of any applicants requesting early ordination. There will not be another meeting of the Executive Council before the General Assembly.

If you're like me, waiting is not something you find particularly enjoyable. Waiting in line; sitting in a waiting room; being stuck in traffic...These things try our patience and make us want to say words that we shouldn't say! Waiting can be very difficult.

It seems to me that God doesn't mind us waiting one little bit. He seems to prefer it that way. "They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength" (Isaiah 40:31) and "Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord" (Psalm 27:14) are just two examples where we are exhorted to be patient and wait on God's timing.

You may have heard Ecclesiastes 11:1 quoted or referred to concerning giving. It says, "Cast your bread upon the water, and after many days, you will find it again." Notice three little words: "After. Many. Days." Uh-oh! God's idea of "after many days" and my idea is probably quite different. I want it to mean "next week sometime". God may be thinking, "years from now".

Whether we like it or not, our part is to be obedient and wait on God's timing.

We may feel like we've given and given in a situation, but nothing has changed; God says, "Wait". We may feel like we have cried and prayed until there are no tears or words left; God says, "Wait". Perhaps you have written a particular request on a prayer card year after year, and still, the answer is "Not yet." Argh!!

I love the way Eugene Peterson paraphrases Romans 8:24-25 in the Message: "Waiting does not diminish us any more than waiting diminishes a pregnant mother. We are enlarged in the waiting." Evidently God knows that the waiting is good for us. It helps us grow and mature, becoming a better version of the person we were created to be.

Whether your prayer is answered in 2026 or "After. Many. Days," - keep on praying, keep on believing and keep on loving others in spite of the situation. What is birthed from the experience will be worth the wait.
