


2025-2026 MISSIONS GOAL: \$30,000



BUCKET LISTS OF LANDMARKS?



We are such collectors. We collect various items, including pictures, videos, and even people (whom we refer to as "friends" and "followers"), as well as collectibles (such as the California Raisins). The list goes on and on. There is nothing that epitomizes our passion for collecting things like our love affairwith "Bucket Lists." Whether official or unofficial, clear or vague, most of us have a list of things we want to do and places we want to go before we die.

We've all done it. Come back from a vacation exhausted because we determined to check off several things on our bucket list. But the word "list" is a dead giveaway. What do we do with lists? We check them off, and then the lists no longer matter. It's the following list that matters. Checking off all the things on our list feels really good... for a few minutes. But come tomorrow morning, we will be doodling out a brand-new list. Yesterday's feel-good moment is history, and now we're off to the races again. My friend, there's a better way; I call it landmarking memories. I got the idea from a book I read over twenty years ago titled Soul Salsa, by Leonard Sweet. Sweet wrote: "There is one day in your life that will be your best day.

There is one day in your life that will be your worst day. It's essential to recognize when you're experiencing one of life's most memorable moments and its opposite. Landmark both." As the idea for this letter began to take shape in my mind, a landmark moment occurred to me on a summer afternoon in Bismarck, ND. Ruby, my granddaughter, and I were on the back porch watering some plants. Ruby was about two years old at the time, and she was fascinated by the water hose. When I finished, I adjusted the water spouts lightly and adjusted the water pressure, then handed her the water hose. She eagerly pressed the handle on the nozzle, and the water shot up into the sky. She was indescribably thrilled, raptured into bliss. I'll never forget the look on her face and the wonder in her eyes. Her entire body was vibrating with almost uncontrollable excitement. I remember thinking to myself,



"I must never forget this moment." And I haven't; I landmarked itby recording it in my journal and by putting a recurring reminder in my calendar. Here's the fantastic thing about landmarks and what makes them different from bucket lists... Once the bucket list deed is checked off, you have to move on to the next thing to feel that excitement again. But when you have a landmark moment, every time you revisit that moment, you experience the joy again. In fact, landmark moments become increasingly precious as the years pass. While serving in the Dakotas and Montana, I experienced several moments that checked off my bucket list. Yellowstone and Old Faithful were amazing. The Grand Tetons and Glacier National Park were even better.

I was surprised at how moving it was to visit Mt. Rushmore, and the ND Badlands were like something from another world...the first time. Every time we had guests come over, they also wanted to see those things (they had a bucket list). I was glad to take them to see these things, but each time I went, it was never the same again. I'd already done those things and checked them off my list. But landmark moments –they never grow old nor lose their appeal. And that leads me to what I really want to say: Michigan Church of God, we must not turn church into a Bucket List. Sunday worship must not be just another item on our weekly to-do list. We can't let the church become just another string of activities and programs. We must come expecting every Sunday, every event, and every activity to be a landmark moment—a moment when God can truly and actually show up to do something transforming.

Bottom line, whatever we do, we must never lose the wonder—for when the wonder is gone, the joy is also gone and all we have left is duty and memories. That's not how it is meant to be. Here's praying for landmark moments for the Michigan Church of God!
