1. What most impacted you from the message?
2. Jesus doesn't reject Thomas, although Thomas required proof of the resurrection. It's easy for us to condemn Thomas, but if we were actually there, what doubts might we have had? What proof might we have asked for?
3. Jesus took on all the sins of the world and God raised Him from the dead. Yet, are there struggles in your life that you still don't trust God to handle?
4. For those of us with conflict, the resurrection reconciles our relationships. Peter denied Jesus three times and the others just ran away. Yet after the resurrection, Jesus makes sure to restore His relationship with them. In what ways are you believing the enemy's lies of unforgiveness about yourself and others?
5. For those of us who lack direction, the resurrection reminds us of our purpose. Have you ever felt that God has forgotten you, or doubted that He has a plan for your life? Explain. In what ways has God then reminded you that He does care about you and has a plan for your life? Did He accomplish this in a way far different than you expected?
