FAFC Questions

1. What was the most insightful thing for you in the message?

2. We all face desperate times in life. For Moses, it was at the Red Sea. For the disciples, it was a storm. For the desperate widows, it was a place of survival. Can you recall a time in your life when you were completely desperate for an answer? What was happening?

3. What are some of the most difficult times that we face where we realize we cannot solve the problem? (Spiritually, emotionally, relationally, physically, etc.) What kind of concerns do they bring? Which of these rises to the top for you? Do you believe God really cares in those times? Why do we tend to question that?

4. In the story in 2 Kings 4, Elijah asks the woman two questions. What were they? What is the significance of both of these questions? Why is the second question equally important to the first question? How does God involve us in the answers to the problems that we face? Does He want to do the miracle alone or do we play a role?

5. Share a testimony with someone (or remember) a time when God came through for you. What is the reason God wants to bless you? Did you do anything to partner in the answer? Are you facing a time right now? Tell the Lord what you need Him to do and ask the Lord what He wants you to do. Pray for His answer.
